



## Staley-Rouse House - circa 1909

Owner: Town of Frisco

- Originally built for William (a freighting company owner) and Alvarena Staley in 1909.
- After her husband's death in 1908 from a wagon accident (3 months before the house was finished), Mrs. Staley resided there until 1933.
- Mrs. Staley later remarried a man named David Rouse, a teamster and miner.
- Listed on Colorado State Register of Historic Places in 2007 by the Town of Frisco.
- Significant for its architecture - a rare example of vertical and horizontal hewn log construction in a domestic design.
- Difficult keyed half-notching reflects Nordic (possibly Finnish) influences in the design and construction.
