Asphalt/Concrete Cuts: Any cuts from edge to center line must be patched to center line. Any cuts beyond center line must be patched completely across the street. Asphalt cuts shall be either parallel or perpendicular to the roadway. Infrared pavement patching will be required for all pavement patches in rec paths and when the existing roadway asphalt is less than three (3) years old. (Per Town Code, Section 87-10 A & B) Asphalt cuts shall be patched back within 20 days of completion of work. (Per Town Code, Section 87-5 C.)

**Excavated Material:** All excavated materials shall stay on property, not to be stored in the right-of-way. (Per Town Code, Section 127-39)

**Water Line:** All water lines must be constructed per the Town of Frisco Water Construction Standards. All lines must be inspected prior to CO, inspections require 24 hournotice.

Additional requirements for construction/restoration include: Compaction (min. 95%); Reconstruction of base/sub-base; Traffic Control as required by MUTCD Standards; Re-grading of shoulders/borrow ditch; Culvert installations shall have a minimum 12" cover of compacted Class 6 road base; Culvert material must be approved by the Public Works Department.
