

HISTORIC WALKING TOUR OF FRISCO

Take an interactive audio tour throughout Frisco by calling **970.281.3001** and entering the stop number at the prompt to learn more about these landmarks.

1. FRISCO HISTORIC PARK & MUSEUM (INCLUDES STOPS 1-11)

Located at 120 Main St., this historic settlement features 11 buildings. The free museum is open to the public and is the best place to start your historic tour or Frisco.

2. OLD TOWN HALL

Located at 3rd & Main St., this building was originally built as a Town Hall and Community Center for hosting square dances & potluck dinners. The Town of Frisco now uses the building at the Information Center.

3. FOOTE'S REST

Located between 5th & 6th Avenue on Main St., this property once served as Frisco's Post Office, General Store and Gas Station. The main building was a single room wood-plank cabin and is listed on the National Register of Historic Places. It was known as Foote's rest in the 1940s-60s.

4. STALEY-ROUSE HOUSE

Located at 518 Main St. next to Foote's Rest, this building represents a unique style of pioneer log construction. This building is on the Colorado State Register of Historic Properties.

5. FRISCO CEMETERY

Located next to the Frisco Bay Marina and bike path, this is the resting place for many historic figures.

6. LUND HOUSE & DILLON RESERVOIR

A historic ranch house relocated to the Frisco Bay Marina now overlooks Dillon Reservoir and what used to be the Town of Dillon.

7. MASONTOWN

Located at the base of Mount Royal near the recreation path on the south side of Frisco. On this easy to moderately difficult hike, you will discover remnants of an old mining town destroyed by an avalanche in 1926.

8. COKE OVENS

Located near the County Commons, south of Frisco on the recreation path, which used to be the railroad bed, are the remnants of kiln-type ovens used to produce coal between 1885 and 1910.
