The following clarifications are issued:

The Civil drawings (C series) in Exhibit D are to be bid as base scope. The Owner waives the mandatory requirement of bid walk attendance as noted in the RFQP. It is currently unknown if any SWPPP is required for the site. Alternate #3 is to be bid as the complete site grading with the exception of the skate park area.

The following Q/A are issued:

Q: Is the landscape area within the skate park part of base bid scope? A: The landscape area within the skate park is part of the skate park design-build contract and will not be part of the project bid scope.

Q: Is the fence around the skate park part of the base bid scope of work? A: Yes, the fence noted on L 1-01 is a part of base bid scope.

Q: Details 1 and 2 on sheet L 3-03 state by Owner. Are these items installed by owner as well and do they need a foundation?



A: The items noted in in Details 1 and 2 will be Owner Furnished and Owner Installed, including the required foundations.

Q: Please confirm the scope of work is by other for the playground mulch noted on Detail 5 sheet L 3-02.

A: The playground mulch will be installed by the bouldering manufacturer.

Q: Are the permits by Owner or Contractor?

A: The Town of Frisco will be handling permit fees for the project. The contractor is responsible for any required tap fees.

Q: Are the boulders shown on L1-01 and on Detail 8 L 3-02 to be moved by Owner or contractor?

A: The boulders are to be moved by the selected contractor.

Q: Is the warranty period for one (1) or two (2) years? A: The expected warranty is one (1) year.

Q: Is temporary power and electrical meter the responsibility of the contractor? A: Yes, the temporary power and electrical is the selected contractor's responsibility.

Q: Is the site lighting rough in only?

A: Yes, site lighting is rough in.

Q: Will there be a laydown area available for the contractor's use?

A: The Owner will work with the selected contractor to identify an appropriate laydown area.
