The Town of Frisco is accepting proposals for a 2019 model Front End Loader. Proposals are due no later than 1:00 P.M. February 15, 2019

All sealed proposals shall be delivered to the Town of Frisco Attn: Michael Nation; 0102 School Road; P.O. Box 4100; Frisco, CO. 80443

Nothing herein shall require the Town of Frisco to accept any proposals and the Town of Frisco reserves the right to reject any and all proposals. This proposal shall remain open and not withdrawn for a period of 45 days from the date designated for its due date.

Any required or suggested training shall be part of the proposal. Training videos for the operation of the unit will be expected. Additional training will be conducted at the Town of Frisco Public Works Department.

**GENERAL**

This specification includes one 2019 model wheel Loader; Minimum 30,000 pound operating weight and any accessories as described herein. The equipment and attachments shall be new and warranted for a minimum of 7 years, 5000 hours of operation from date of delivery by the machine dealer. Service data shall include illustrated parts book, shop repair manual and operator manual. These requirements are minimum and all exceptions shall be noted. The unit shall meet or exceed the following requirements.

Must couple up to other town loaders  
3 yd bucket with teeth and bolt on wear plates between teeth  
12 foot, fully hydraulic plow parallel to ground in return to dig (same cutting edge angle as one being traded in)

**Trade in**

One 2012 Caterpillar 930K loader each with 3 yd bucket; 12 foot inverted V plow; 1 set of operators and parts manual

**Delivery**

Bid price of the unit and attachments shall include delivery to the Town of Frisco, Public Works Department Frisco CO. A delivery date shall be supplied with the bid.

Any required or suggested training shall be included in the proposal. Training will be conducted at the Town of Frisco Public Works Department whenever needed.
