**PERMIT TO EXCEED LIMITS**

Any person desiring to obtain a permit to exceed the noise levels designated in the Noise Ordinance (**Frisco Town Code 127-53**) may make an application to the town manager. The town manager shall have the authority to grant a permit to exceed the maximum permissible noise levels designated as shown in the chart below. Any permit granted by the town manager under this section shall be effective only for the location and times designated within the permit, and shall be further subject to such conditions as may be set forth in such permit. In determining whether to grant a permit, the town manager shall give consideration to the following seven (7) criteria.
