



## **Town of Frisco Contemporaneous Plumbing Review Procedures**

Pursuant to the Colorado Revised Statutes 12-58-114.5, The Town of Frisco Building Department has established the following procedures for conducting contemporaneous reviews of plumbing licenses. These procedures apply to the inspection of all plumbing work required to be installed by State Licensed Plumbers. Inspections of all plumbing work will only be conducted when a State Licensed plumbing contractor license is provided at the time of plumbing permit application. The Town of Frisco will verify the State Licensure provided, using the Colorado Department of Regulatory Agencies (DORA) website. Frisco plumbing inspectors will request, at their discretion any of the following.

- Verification of plumbing licenses for the plumbers working on the job site for compliance with CRS-12-58-105
- Verification of apprentices working on the job site for compliance with CRS-12-58-117
- That the plumbing contractor is the same as that listed on the issued permit.
- If the inspector is unable to verify the identity or verify of any of the items listed above, the inspector may terminate the inspection, and issue a correction notice. No further inspection will be performed until verification is made.
- Based upon scope and extent of violations, The Town of Frisco Building Department may report the violation to the State Plumbing Board.
- The goal of a contemporaneous review is to advise plumbing contractors of the importance for compliance with the provisions of CRS-12-58, specifically the supervision of apprentices for education of the trades, to improve worker safety and to provide code compliant plumbing installations for the end user.
