




The National Community Survey[™] report is about the "livability" of Frisco.

8 in 10 prioritize environmental sustainability as a medium to high priority.


9 in 10 value Parks and Recreation in Frisco.





Strong local governments produce results that meet the needs of residents while making the best use of available resources, and are responsive to the present and future needs of the community as a whole.








The ease with which residents can move about their communities, whether for commuting, leisure, or recreation, plays a major role in the quality of life for all who live, work and play in the community.






Utilities




Education, Arts, and Culture


