On December 18, 2020, the State of Colorado approved a “5 Star” Business Certification Program in Summit County. Restaurants certified as part of this application and inspection process have to show that they are going above and beyond to protect the health of their employees and customers.

These are the Frisco restaurants which have elected to apply for this certification and have been approved as a Certified “5 Star” Business, and therefore, may open to indoor dining with 25% occupancy and may have extended hours where they can serve alcohol until 9:00pm and food until 10:00pm in their indoor dining areas.
