## Dear Partner,

Expedia Group is now required to collect, report, and remit the City Local Sales Tax and City Lodging Tax in accordance with <u>Town of Frisco Ordinance 21-04</u>

The change does not affect the state and other state-administered local sales and use taxes.

This ordinance applies to all Expedia Collect (EC) bookings made on or after May 1, 2021 for the following Expedia Group brands: Egencia LLC, Expedia, Inc., Hotels.com, L.P., Hotwire, Inc., Numinous LLC, Orbitz LLC, and Travelscape LLC.

## What's changing?

Effective May 1, 2021, Expedia Group will collect, report, and remit the City Sales Tax and City Lodging Tax on all EC bookings.

## What do I need to do?

You no longer need to collect, report, and remit the City Sales Tax or Lodging Tax to the Town of Frisco on any EC bookings. In addition, Expedia Group will continue to collect, report, and remit the following state and state-administered local sales and use taxes on all EC bookings directly to the Colorado Department of Revenue:

- Colorado State Sales and Use Tax
- County Sales and Use Tax
- Summit County Housing Authority Tax (District Sales and Use Tax)
