

BACKFLOW TESTING COMPLIANCE

Frisco Water Customer:

Town of Frisco Water Department records show that your property(s) have one or more backflow devices. This is a REMINDER COLORADO STATE LAW REQUIRES BACKFLOW DEVICES TO BE TESTED YEARLY BY A CERTIFIED BACKFLOW TESTER, and these requirements pertain to multi-family and commercial properties rather than individual homes. Properly functioning backflow prevention devices keep outgoing water from possibly contaminating source water.

In order for Frisco to comply with the Colorado Department of Health and Environment's (CDPHE) requirements for backflow prevention, Frisco Town Council recently approved amendments to the Town Code that establish deadlines for property owners to test their backflow devices and submit the results to the Town. For those property owners who fail to meet these deadlines, fines may be assessed on a daily basis for non-compliance. The Town code amendments establish the following:

Report submission deadlines:

- Backflow device testing reports for <u>domestic and fire suppression</u> devices must be submitted to the Town of Frisco no later than September 1 of each calendar year.
- Backflow device testing reports for <u>irrigation</u> devices must be submitted to the Town no later than July
 31 of each year; due to timing, the irrigation deadline will be extended to September 1 for 2022 only.

Penalties:

- o The penalty for the first offense will be a mandatory fine of \$250.00.
- Any subsequent violation will carry a mandatory fine of \$500.00.
- These fines may be assessed for <u>each day</u> the property is out of compliance within a twelve-month period.
