

Legacy Bench Program Information



The Legacy Bench Program provides an opportunity to honor, remember and pay tribute to loved ones or life events through the purchase of a park bench which includes a commemorative plaque. Legacy Benches also support the Town of Frisco's efforts to enhance our parks and open space properties while benefiting the entire community.

The Town of Frisco also has a Living Legacy donation program for memorial tree donations. Please fill out the corresponding application at FriscoGov.com. Tree and bench donations cannot be combined.

Details of the Program:

- Only one bench is allowed per event or individual being commemorated.
- The style of the bench and plaque is pre-determined based on maintaining a consistent bench model throughout the Town of Frisco.
- Bench plaques are 2" x 10" and allow for up to 56 characters.
- Plaque language will be approved by 2 staff members and the Town of Frisco has the right to deny unacceptable language.
 - Limitations on plaque language include:
 - No business advertising may be allowed. However, a business may donate a bench to acknowledge an individual or group.
 - No language may be used that could be considered offensive to the public.
- Location of the bench is on a first come first served basis, with limited or no availability in some areas. Town staff will have final approval of the location.
 - Available locations on Town owned property include:
 - Pocket Park at 3rd Avenue and Granite Street
 - Pioneer Park where the community tennis courts are located. This bench would be placed in the natural area of the park.
 - Post Office Park- the bench would be placed near the boulder garden and flagstone path.
 - Meadow Creek Park- the bench would be placed on the west side of the park overlooking the pond.

- Town Hall the bench would be placed on the Main Street sidewalk near the bus stop.
- Bike Path- the bench would be placed near Crown Point road at the Peninsula Recreation Area.
- All other locations including the Marina, Historic Park and other Town owned properties DO NOT currently have space available for a memorial bench.
- Benches are placed during the summer.
- Benches always remain property of the Town of Frisco.

Process:

1. If you are interested in the program email a completed application form to the Program Manager, Jessica Holley at JessicaH@townoffrisco.com.
2. Determine final location with a Public Works representative through a site visit.
3. Submit donation to Town of Frisco.
4. Program manager will order the bench and receive a final proof of the plaque text. Allow 6-8 weeks after final approval for delivery.
5. Plaque will be placed on the bench during manufacturing.
6. Allow for 2-3 weeks after delivery until installation. Notification of installation completion will be sent to the applicant.

Program Terms and Costs:

- Cost is \$2,500
- The donation includes: the bench, plaque, installation and maintenance for the life of the bench.
- Major renovations may alter the exact location of the bench, although the location of the bench will remain near the original site as long as feasible.
- Staff cannot guarantee installation by a set due date because of potential workload issues and unforeseen circumstances.
