ATTENTION ALL SNOW REMOVAL CONTRACTORS

After receiving questions and comments regarding the snow removal operations of private contractors, Public Works felt it was necessary to communicate **WHAT IS** and **WHAT IS NOT** acceptable during private snow removal operations.

Chapter 127-38 of the Town Code: *Operation of Snow Removal Equipment by Private Operators*, states the guidelines that private contractors must adhere to during private snow removal operations. We would encourage all contractors to read this ordinance in its entirety to ensure that they are operating accordingly. Failure to do so could result in fines or ticketing.

The most frequent question received would relate to snow storage and interaction with Town property/Town rights-of-way. This is addressed in section B of the ordinance which reads as follows:

B. It shall be unlawful for any person, business or corporation to push or deposit snow or ice upon any street, sidewalk, alley, right-of-way or other public property or any portion thereof.

This would include the pushing of snow across the Town right-of-way to deposit it to another pile or piles.

It has also been noticed that the Town's pathways have been used by private contractors to shuttle equipment from one area of the Town to another. Remember that these pathways are for authorized vehicles only, and all unauthorized vehicles must use the roadways like other motor vehicles.

We appreciate your cooperation with this and know that this is because Public Works wants to ensure there is ample room for all parties to complete snow removal operations in the most effective manner possible. The Town rights-of-way were intended to be used for roadway snow storage and not for private usage. This is something that benefits the Town as a whole, and when that space is taken up it becomes a safety issue. Each property in Frisco was developed with snow storage in mind and those areas were designated at the time of design and design approval.
