

SUBMISSION #1: CHRISTIE CHARLESTON

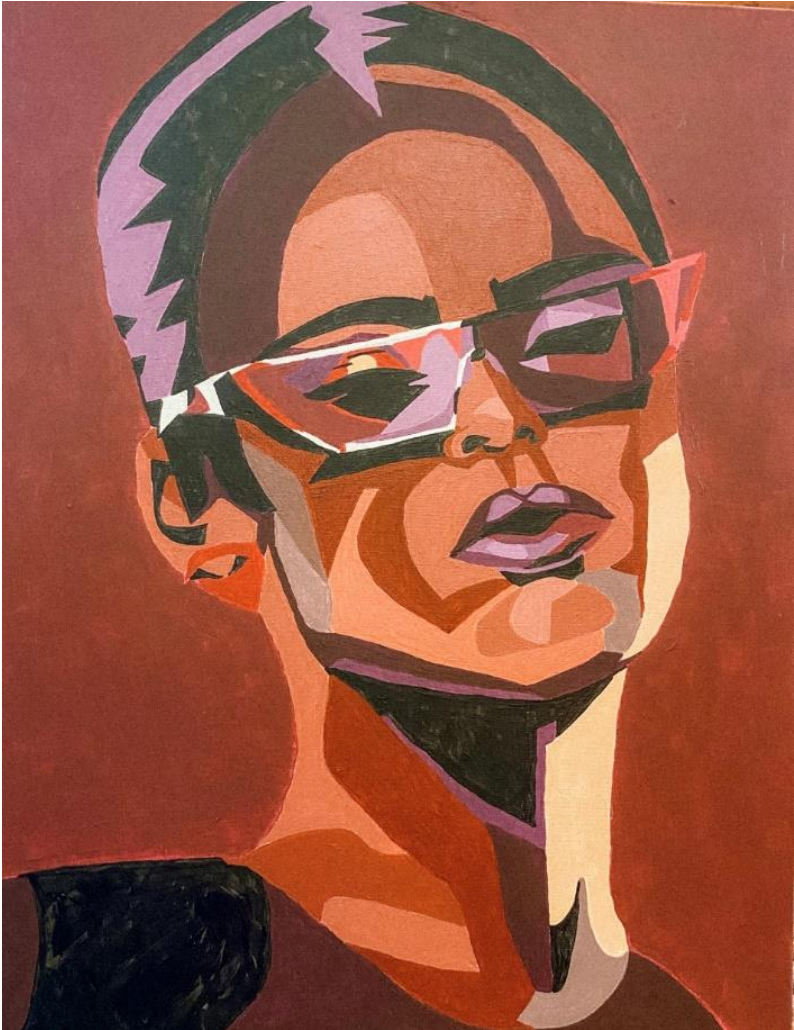
FROM THE ARTIST:

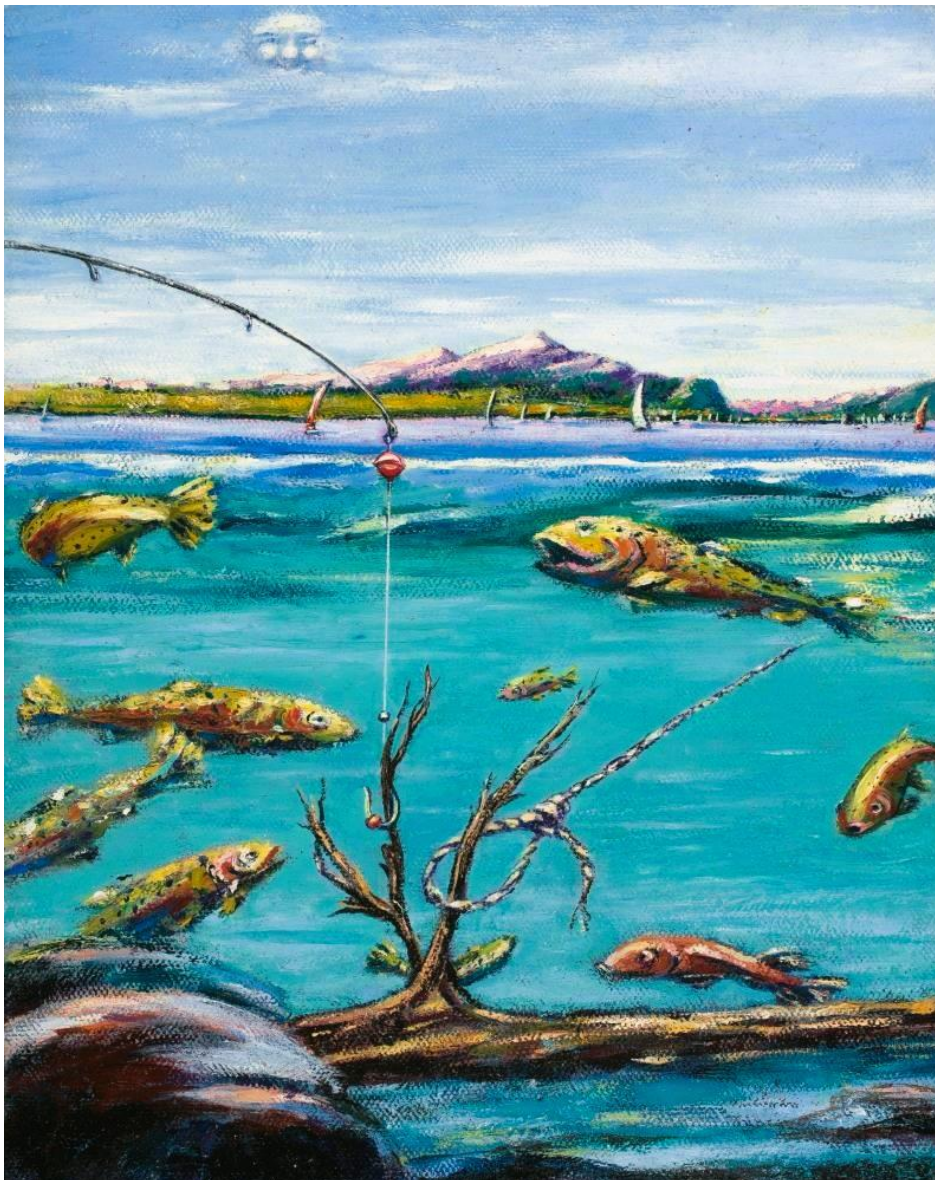
SUBMISSION #3: NANCY BRANCA

FROM THE ARTIST:

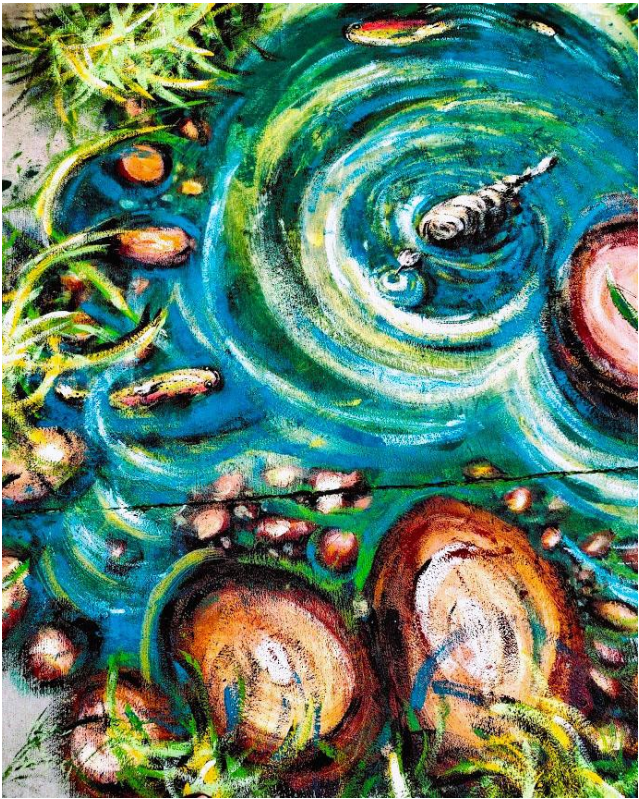

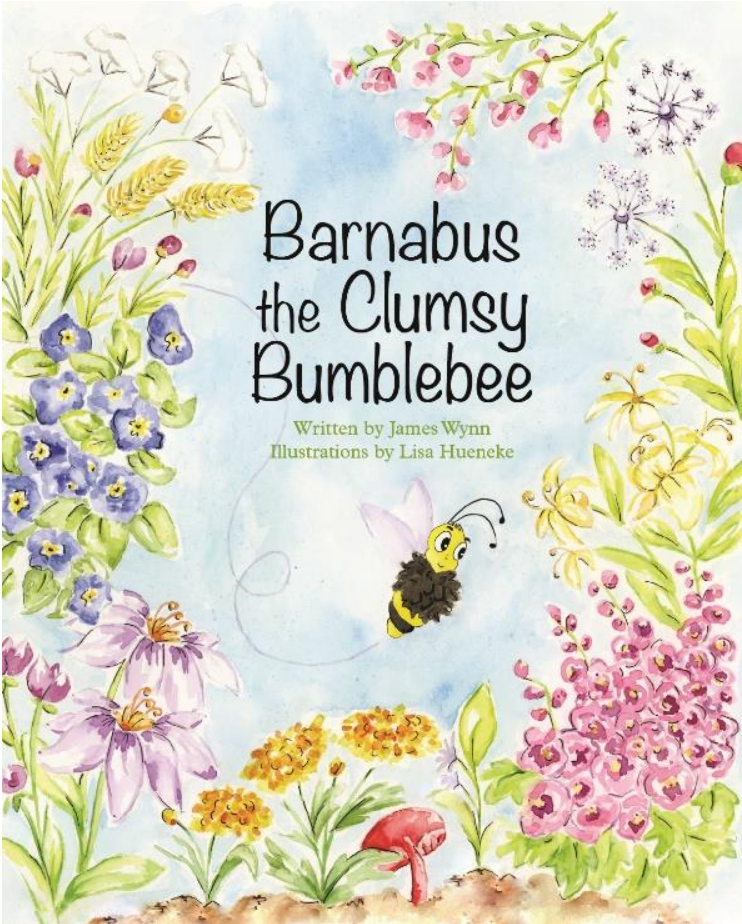

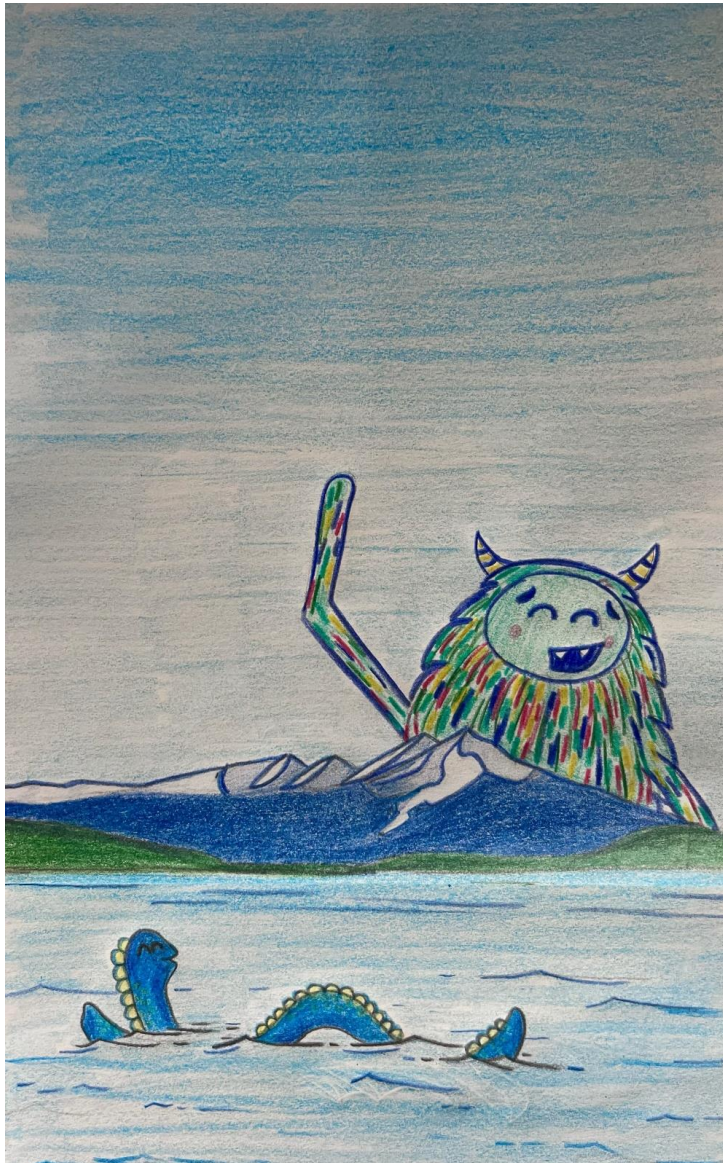
