 - Town Council Work Session- February 13, 2024 from 4:00 – 4:45 pm
 - This is a conversation with Town Council, and staff will provide a supporting memo and a PowerPoint presentation to start and support this conversation.

 - Staff will send out sign up form for the wassail station

- Project Discussion- 60 minutes
 - Goal 2: Music *NEW*
 - Review the plan for music and youth
 - Youth Sound & Light Workshop
 - Todd Altschuler offered Ten Mile Music Hall and to offer introductions to staff who could teach this.
 - Have four groups over five hours for a one-hour session each: Adult, high school, middle school, and elementary and split between sound and lighting.
 - Do different nights
 - \$10 per session for either light or sound
 - Have first session in March
 - Distribute info to schools (theatre, music, and art depts), dance studios, etc...
 - Estimate- \$500 for a ½ day session
 - Open Discussion
 - Fostering more music lessons/learning

- Identify instructors and sources for instruments- have staff create a directory of instructors and have it live online (maybe under youth programs at TownofFrisco.com)
 - Provide lesson scholarships to Upper Tenmile Basin residents only- staff to create an application for FACC to review
 - Provide music and songwriting workshops in the future
 - Group considered finding public spaces to assist with lesson locations, but they believed that this would not be fair to instructors who are paying rent in Frisco.
 - Host a talent show at Ten Mile Music Hall in the future
- Sculpture Maintenance and Treatment Plan
 - Select Maintenance and Treatment Plan for 2024
 - Staff would recommend fixing the sculptures and going for yearly maintenance plan- FACC approved this approach
- Tunnel Mural Schedule
 - Provide input regarding draft RFP
 - Confirm project schedule – FACC would like staff to shorten up the schedule to allow more time for CDOT to review
 - February- FACC reviews RFP/Creative Description; staff sends RFP out
 - March- FACC reviews applications and works with artists on the final design
 - April/May- Final review of design; Staff submits application packet to CDOT- submit mid May at the latest
- RecPath Mural Schedule (Move to February meeting)
 - Confirm location and target amount of murals
 - Confirm project schedule
 - February- Finalize details for RFP
 - March- Staff sends RFP out
 - April- FACC reviews applications and organize scavenger hunt
 - May- FACC approves the design for the scavenger hunt. Staff orders items and collateral
 - June- Installation
- Community Movie Night
 - Each FACC member bring three movie choices to the meeting
 - Todd- Princess Bride, any Willie Wonka and the new Jungle Book
 - Daymon- Princess Bride, Fantastic Mr. Fox
 - Diane- Princess Bride, War of the Worlds, Body Snatchers, The Day the Earth Stood Still, Fantastic Voyages
 - Megan- Princess Bride, The Sandlot, Fantastic Mr. Fox
 - Jamie- Princess Bride, Point Break, Surf's Up
 - Ally- Mrs. Doubtfire, Jack Black Movies like School of Rock
