 - Fourth of July Projects- Stipend, Contest, Art Float – Todd has reached out to all Main Street businesses with the flyer, we have two applications for the stipend right now, and art float is in progress
 - Movie Night at the Marina- Moving along with planning... still need to book band and get confirmation from food trucks
 - CDOT Tunnel Mural- Design has already been submitted to CDOT. CDOT needs to approve the design and then the tunnel can be prepped.
 - Temporary Summer Murals- Do not limit to just local artists but say “we encourage local and Colorado artists to apply” and only require examples of past work
 - Sound and Lighting Workshops- Consider scheduling in the fall when school starts
- Project Discussion- 30 minutes
 - Storytellers Series-
 - FACC needs to work on figuring out the purpose of this project... general storytelling, memorializing an era in Frisco, have a community event, preserving Frisco culture...?

- Todd suggested that we look at [The YX factor: Telluride, Colorado, 1970s](#) for an example of memorializing culture and asked the FACC to consider if they find this film interesting.
- Daymon would like it to be a classic podcast format with audio and video with groups of people talking.
- Krystal and Phil Lindeman willing to work with us on this.
- Daymon to look for a host and tech providers for the “memorializing Frisco’s past” project and will bring back for the next meeting.
- Group agreed that we have time to figure this out. Likely, this is two different projects: memorializing Frisco’s past and telling general stories.
- FACC to review the examples below prior to the meeting and come prepared to discuss what you would like to see in a Frisco storytelling series such as format, timeline, people, and topics
