- Member Updates
  - Recap of Josh Blanchard, Colorado Creative Industries Director, presentation
    - Surprise at Colorado's low funding levels for arts and culture
    - There is an interest from CCI to combine arts and culture with other community initiatives that seek to resolve community issues.
    - Would be great to work across counties in the future and look for funding

  - Fourth of July Float-
    - Stipend info will go out on Monday, along with parade registration and marketing staff will create a flyer digital and print for FACC to distribute
    - Float commission has been determined- Dillon, Breck Create, Silverthorne and Frisco arts groups weighed in and chose Bree Angela <https://www.breeangela.com/> with Dillon likely providing the flatbed trailer
  - Wassail Days mug- five submissions so far and they will be reviewed in April
  - Colorado Creative Industries Summit- May 1-2, 2025, Grand Junction, CO- FACC to make decisions by March 31

- FACC decision by March 30- will email reminders to see who can attend
- Projects
  - Walter Byron Bathroom Mural-
    - FACC would like to paint four separate sections- would be about \$5k with \$500 for materials
    - Jamie suggested that we ask the artist to focus on specific, more visible areas with more details and to match the colors to the playground
  - Songwriting Workshop- Jill and Tyler are now not available for a three-week course (one for adults and one for teens) until fall 2025. FACC is fine with fall.
    - Daymon suggested getting Krystal involved.
    - FACC interested in a “school of rock” type songwriting contest, possibly with a local band/musician performing the song.
    - FACC would like to have people sign up for a full three-week session- call it fundamentals of songwriting
    - Jill and Tyler Recommendations:
      - 3-week course covering lyrics and music
      - Each week is at a different level and has separate sign-ups
      - Week 1: Beginner/The Never Evers
      - Week 2: Intermediate
      - Week 3: Intermediate Plus
      - Future- develop an expert level that includes recording
      - Future- include a band management session
      - 90 minutes per week- 60 minutes of joint work- 30-minute breakout sessions focused on music or lyrics
      - High School course and Adult (18+) course
      - 10 ppl per class- 15 max if we get a lot of attention
      - At Roasters- the space lends itself to splitting into lyrics and music breakout sessions. Tim already gave tentative permission to Jill for after-hours.
    - **Costs:**
      - \$250/session/instructor= \$3k for total program
      - \$20-\$25 per person per week. 10 people per session. 60 spots total
      - Suggestion: discount if signing up for all three weeks
      - Max revenue possible is \$1200-\$1500
      - to cover workshop costs in full would be \$50/person/session

- FACC covering 50% of costs at \$25/week
- Summer programming
  - Try to do an art workshop once a quarter- have FACC provide artist contacts who are easygoing- reach to artist from the fall- Patty Vincent and reach to Jill at Breck Create about similar easy to work with artists
  - Do a dance class series – two step, line dancing, waltz, flamenco etc... Would Sara at Alpine Dance be interested?
