- Member Updates
 - FACC enjoyed the Walter Byron mural and want to keep these artists in mind for other projects
 - Megan Testin would like the FACC to be involved in the Pioneer Park design process- Vanessa to follow up and see who was awarded this contract
 - Todd Altschuler suggested looking into a mini golf course with art on each hole
- Staff Updates
 - July 4 Parade- All three winners were stipend recipients. Let's not do music with the parade announcer.
 - Walter Byron mural- FACC suggested interpretive signage at the site, and Blair will reach out to the artists for a 60-80 word description to put on the plaque. We have a sticker for this mural. There is an interest to have these artists do other animal murals around town.
 - RecPath murals- There are stickers coming for both of these murals too. We will do a media release for the sticker treasure hunt, and the map has been updated.
 - Tunnel repair update- Pacific Coast is not concerned about the exterior. Staff believes that hiring someone to repaint the interior is the way to go.
 - SPARK Breck Create- Blair and Vanessa attended and thought it was an interesting installation and festival.
 - Movie Night at the Marina- Went well, five vendors, DJ Crisp provided music and emcee duties, solid attendance, and improved electrical infrastructure. Do a survey for next year's movie choice and do three movie choices with one

open ended choice. Put the survey out in May. Some suggestions- Jaws, Up, Finding Nemo, What about Bob, The Sandlot, Goonies

- Wassail Mug text selection- Athelos
- Songwriting workshops- Blair is going to meet with the two teachers in the next month for a “refresher” or “jumpstart” workshop, which would be four songwriting classes and four composition classes with solid descriptions regarding what to expect. Ask if four classes or workshops are enough? What would the focus and syllabus be?
- Eat Ski Be Merry is on January 31 and FACC involvement will be discussed at the September meeting
- Blair and Megan reaching out to the art and music teachers at Frisco Elementary, the Middle School, and Snowy Peaks to make them aware of the FACC and their interest in continuing to work with schools
