- Approval of August 29, 2025, Meeting Minutes
- Member Updates
 - Feedback about movie night- have a chair zone only in the back half of the field
 - Getting great feedback about murals and would like social media posts to spread
- Staff Updates
 - Tunnel repair update- working with Michael who originally prepped the tunnel and repairs will likely not happen until next year.
 - Wassail Mug update – Wassail mugs have been delivered and were given to FACC members
 - Pioneer Park- Todd Altschuler, Melissa Sherburne, Diane Harty Schlaefer, and Megin Testin may be interested in the stakeholder meetings.
 - Budget- We now have an arts fund so all revenue would go in this fund, and the fund balance will grow.
- Projects
 - Songwriting workshops- Blair has had contact with Tyler, and he wants a 15 person cap, people with a musical background (not beginner guitarists), wants four classes: class 1 refresh, class 2 and 3 nuts and bolts, and class 4 playing your original music; Tyler will provide descriptions of each each of the classes for communication/marketing purposes. Bring your own instruments and have it be 16 or up. Four weeks in a row and once a week. You could sign up for as many as you want. For the last class- have a drummer (about \$250). John Truscelli would assist with the lyric portion. FACC would like us to look at a showcase if possible.

- Frozen Frisco – Eat, Ski, & Be Merry is on January 31, 2026- Group believes that we should pursue new efforts for 2026, as it is a bit stale at this point.
- Brainstorm potential future projects-
 - Todd would like us to revisit a “community dinner” based on how popular Fall Fest was and how well it worked. FACC to look at vail.gov/community/art-and-culture/vail-social#ad-image-6 and would like staff to recap the notes from when this discussion first happened. Would like this to be less cliquy, would like restaurants to be involved, and would like to ensure food safety. Would also like to articulate Frisco mountain culture during this event.
 - Halloween- would like a Frisco Arts and Culture photo booth in the center of 4th and Main.
 - Have commissions with more permanent art. Would like to investigate mosaics and more things on vertical surfaces. Look at art in the Old Town Hall Park on the face of the concrete bench.
 - Elk move to Adventure Park was discussed and the planned social media coverage
 - Melissa would like to look at “paint a chair lift” again and have them painted by artists
 - Melissa would like us to have more pop-up workshops.
 - Look at offering an anime workshop
 - FACC will bring workshop ideas to the next FACC meeting.
