- Member Updates
 - Consider a May Day Celebration for 2027- gathering, May Day pole, food, get together, dancing, arts festival... Make a ski tower for the pole... partner with the high school
- Staff Updates
 - Movie Night voting is now open
 - Frisco Adventure Park mural- mural on the snowmaking building on Recreation Way near the Nordic Center Lodge has been enthusiastically endorsed by the Adventure Park staff.
 - 150 Banners- designed and artists/students have been sent their \$50 award.
 - Fourth of July
 - Stipends- have had some interest
 - Judges- no availability from the FACC
 - Colorado Creative Industries Summit June 4-5 in Trinidad, Colorado- Several FACC members are interested, and Jamie Callahan is already signed up
 - Tunnel mural repair- meeting on May 15 to figure it out
- Projects
 - Old Town Hall Park Mosaic- will do an RFP for this with PRA mural being the priority
 - PRA Mural- will do an RFP for this
- Discussion of Arts & Culture Hub - Community Makers Space, Studio Collective & Creative Venue at Former Frisco Library at 90 Madison Ave, Frisco, CO
 - Andy Held and Melissa Sherburne provided some background and a summary of the conversations with Kelly
 - Would like clarity on who Kelly is representing- group of artists, herself, or a non-profit?
 - 1st and Main and the Old Community Center are redevelopment opportunities and to be aware of that
 - Feels like there is an opportunity for a group of artists to use spaces if the Town pays to improve the space
 - Arts Alive is looking for ways to fund the arts in our community and to partner

- Have a subcommittee to work with Kelly and Arts Alive or any other ideas that would start moving us to goal #2 to have an arts hub- Melissa Sherburne and Daymon Pascual have volunteered to work on this
 - Do we want to create a RFP to call for artists to form an arts hub or to do an RFP for artists to teach workshops- recommend to Town Council? Forming an arts hub feels premature at this point, but there may be some interest in a RFP for artists to teach workshops and keep the registrations if the Town markets and handles registration and any registration expenses.
 - Speak to Fruita about the “Farm” which is now largely empty, including the shop
 - Council talked about the Frisco arts community, including Gatherhouse, Arts Alive, Emporium, etc... and how they invest in their businesses and endeavors... so it is challenge to think that we should provide a space and salary to have someone run a similar endeavor in a Town owned property at this point.
