



The Frisco Arts and Culture Council (FACC) is seeking an artist to design artwork for new waste and recycling receptacles along Frisco's Main Street.

Project Summary

A total of 36 new waste and recycling receptacles will be installed at 18 locations along Main Street, bringing with it the opportunity to bring public art to prominent locations for visitors and locals. Each location will consist of two receptacles placed alongside each other (images and measurements of the receptacles are attached at the end of this letter). We are seeking nine (9) cohesive designs from one artist. The designs created will be repeated to fill the entirety of 18 locations along Main Street.

The design for these receptacles cannot impede upon the functionality and legibility of operational use. The artwork will become a part of the town's public art collection with long-term care and maintenance managed by the FACC and may be used on additional receptacles added in years to come.

Honorarium

The honorarium is \$10,000 total, which shall constitute full compensation for all services, goods, and expenses. The honorarium will be paid 50% upon signing the contract, and the remaining 50% will be paid upon completion of the installation.

Project Details

The Frisco Arts and Culture Council seeks artists from across the local, regional, state-wide, and national community. The selected artist must sign a contractor agreement and complete a W-9.

Designs may be representational or abstract. Designs should appeal to audiences of all ages. Art containing advertising, logos, or copyrighted images, and political, commercial, religious, or sexual themes will not be considered.

The final deliverable for this project must be an Adobe InDesign file. The vinyl printing and application of artwork to the receptacles will be conducted by the receptacle fabricating company. An InDesign template file will be sent to the selected artist that includes receptacle shape and size.



Application Requirements

1. Artists must submit at least two and no more than six examples or links to examples of their completed work that depict the artistic style that they intend to use for the project.
2. Artists should include a written paragraph describing their applicable experience and why this project interests them.

Criteria used to select artwork include but are not limited to: quality of the artist's previous work and how that work will translate to a suitable and aesthetic design for the receptacles, which will hold broad-based interest and appeal for all ages and complement and enhance the character of Frisco Main Street.

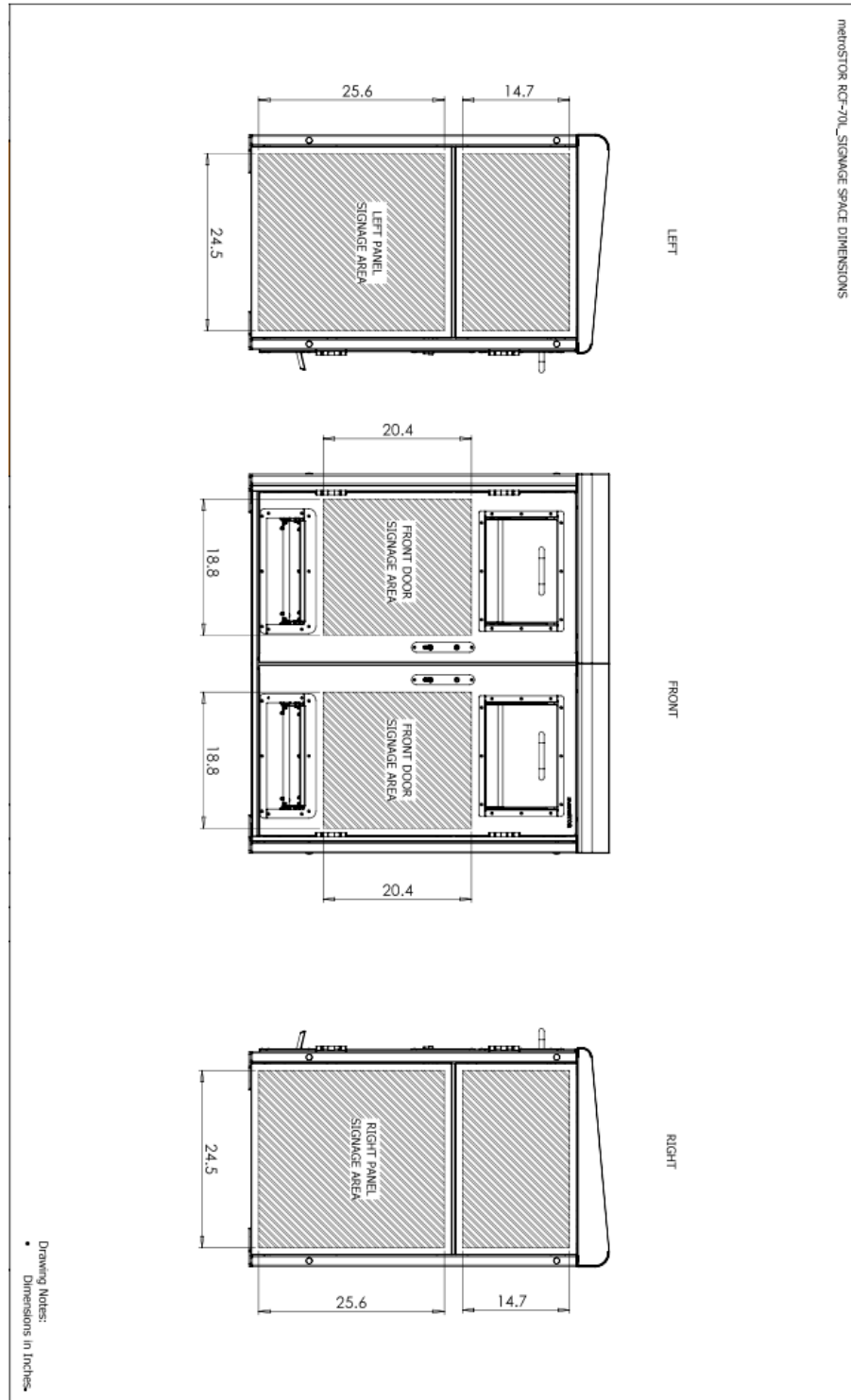

November/December 2026	Receptacles are installed along Main Street

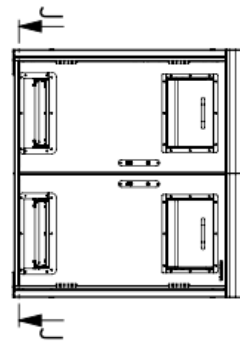
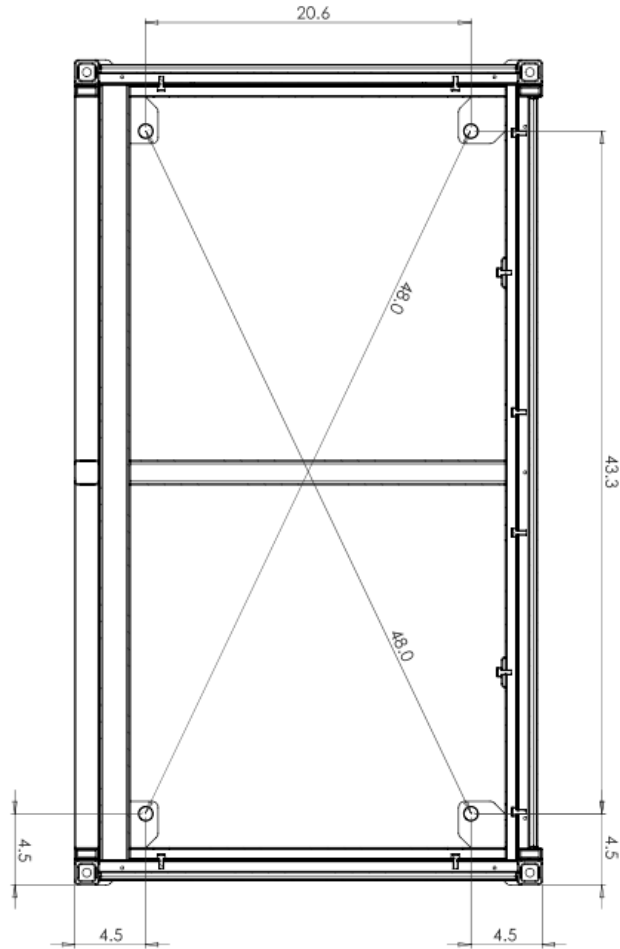


Measurements of Receptacles
