- Approval of June 19, 2026, Meeting Minutes
- Member Updates and Discussion
 - Instrument scholarship program discussion- Megan Testin led the discussion about offering instrument scholarships to Frisco Middle Schoolers. There was a suggestion that we find out what the needs are. There was an interest in offering to all students in the Town of Frisco jurisdictional boundaries. FACC would like staff to approach the high school, middle school, and elementary school teachers to find out what the needs are.

Staff will ask: What are their needs? Do schools need music supplies and repairs? Maybe include an instrument collection program at the repair fair. Blair to reach to music teachers at the elementary school, middle school, and high school, as well as the Green Team.
 - Community dinner discussion- Provide tables and giant fondue pots- some concerns about fondue pots. Maybe just provide a long table down Main Street with decorations and white table clothes and everyone brings dishes. Create the space and see what happens! Chocolate fondue provided by the FACC- George Costanza no double dipping signs. Will ask for dates at the next meeting.
 - Groucho Dinners- staff (Vanessa) will investigate the idea and software. Dinners in local restaurants.
 - Halloween- have a Halloween photobooth (Vanessa to source)
 - Town Council meeting recap- overall it went well, including support for larger asks about a large sculpture, art space, and community dinner

- RFP- workshops- Frisco provides marketing, registration, and location and artist would keep fees
- Staff Updates
 - July 4th stipend recap- 2026 five \$1,000 stipends were awarded and two \$500 stipends
 - VIC/Old Town Hall Park mosaic- three sections of concrete walls/benches in the Old Town Hall Park- first quote is \$28,000 from the Colorado Mosaic Artists. Would be good to have an artist who has outdoor experience. Think about this design in a more comprehensive way and create more of a living room with other pieces in the plaza. Have ways to draw people in and have them linger. Looking to Megan Testin to guide us a bit more on how to cohesively put public art and some lighting in this park and draw in more people.
 - Main Street waste and recycling receptacle art- already have two submissions- FACC will select in mid-September
- Projects
 - PRA Mural artist selection- Chose two – no words- fitting the location (terrain park, tubing hill, bike park, skate park, ski ride hill, disc golf course, Nordic Center)...- feedback- gravitated to the boot design, to the comic book and youthful feel, and to the strong black/brown and white design not reliant on just color
 - Wassail mug design – FACC loves it. Would like the moose to have legwarmers and need a year to be added. Will be reviewed at September meeting.
